Wild Goose Resource Group is a member of **PRS for Music/ MCPS**, who handle performance/ mechanical rights on our behalf. PRS covers music broadcast on TV or radio, performed or played in public, live or recorded, streamed or downloaded. MCPS covers music copied as CDs/ DVDs, streamed or downloaded, used in TV, film or radio.

If you have a Limited Online Music Licence, this covers the communication to the public of PRS/MCPS members' repertoire through digital services.

#### **CCLI**

WGRG is a member of CCLI.

Available as an add-on to the Church Copyright Licence, from 21<sup>st</sup> March 2020, CCLI's new Church Streaming Licence, combined with the Limited Online Music Licence (LOML) from PRS for Music, permits you to legally webcast your services, including the worship music. Includes streaming to Facebook and Youtube.

#### **ONE LICENSE**

WGRG's US publisher, GIA Publications, is a member publisher of ONE LICENSE, which is providing a worldwide gratis streaming licence valid until April 15<sup>th</sup> 2020.

A ONE LICENSE Podcast/ Streaming License grants permission to podcast or stream religious services that contain music from its Member Publishers.

This allows your organisation to live stream or post pre-recorded services on your website, Facebook page, YouTube, or other social media.

For new customers or for existing customers who do not already have a Podcast / Streaming License, ONE LICENSE is offering a one-month gratis license.

A PRS Limited Online Music Licence does not cover content on third party websites and social media platforms such as YouTube or Facebook.
